Dutch sustainable public procurement strategy

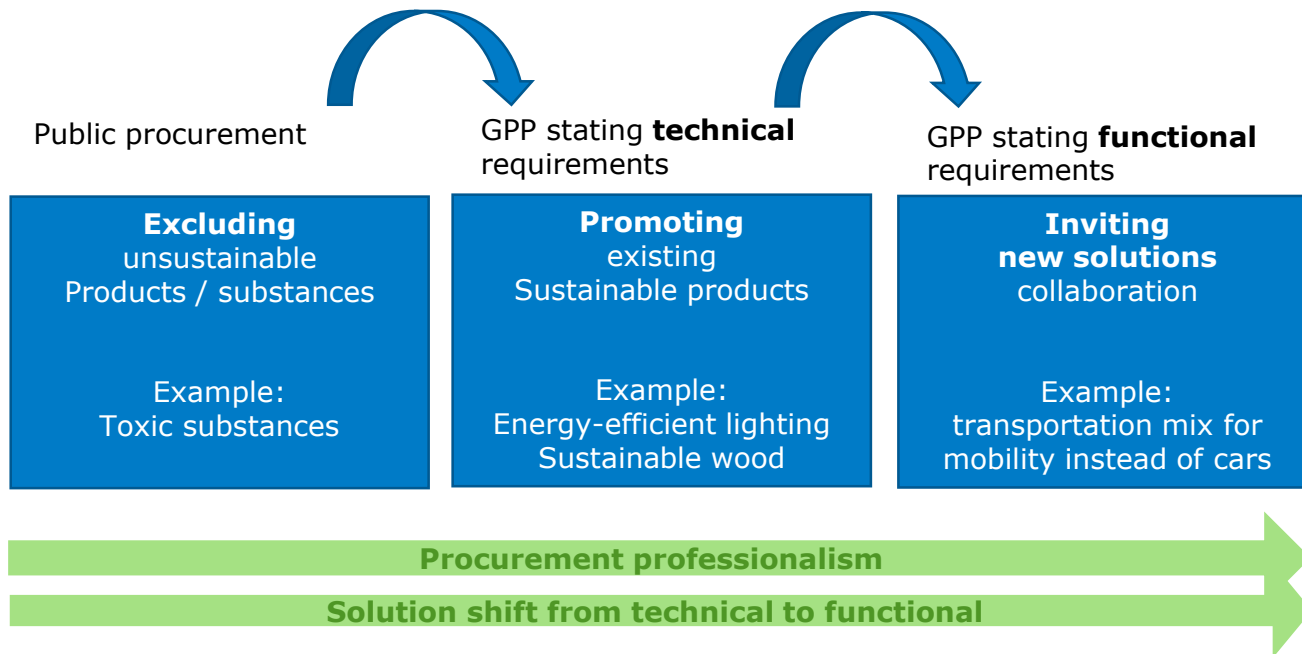
- Annual expenditure of about 73 billion from all governments
- Of which about 10 billion from central government
- Of which about half from the ministry of infrastructure and water management
- A major focus on the circular and climate transition

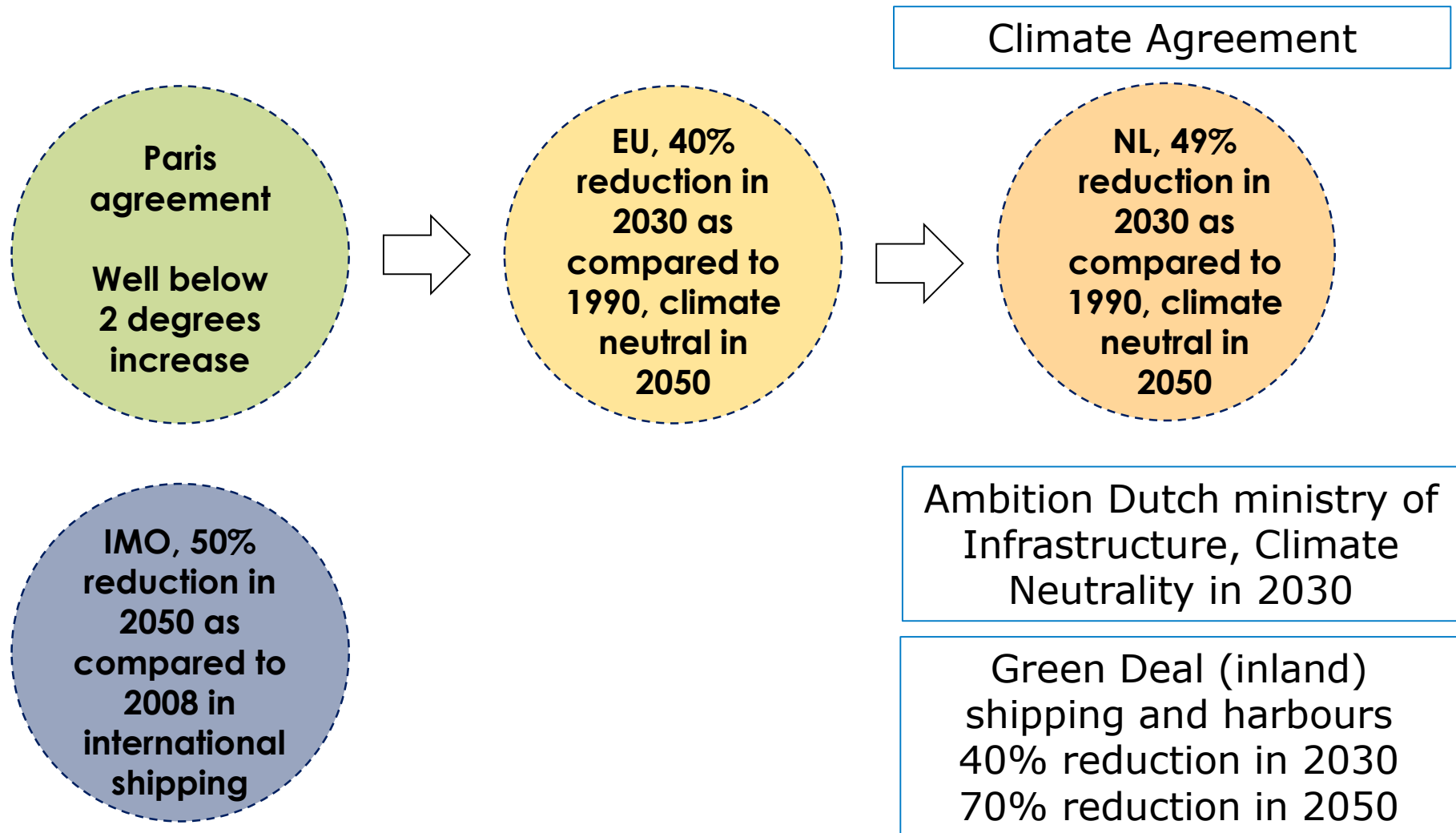


Development stages in Green Public Procurement (GPP)



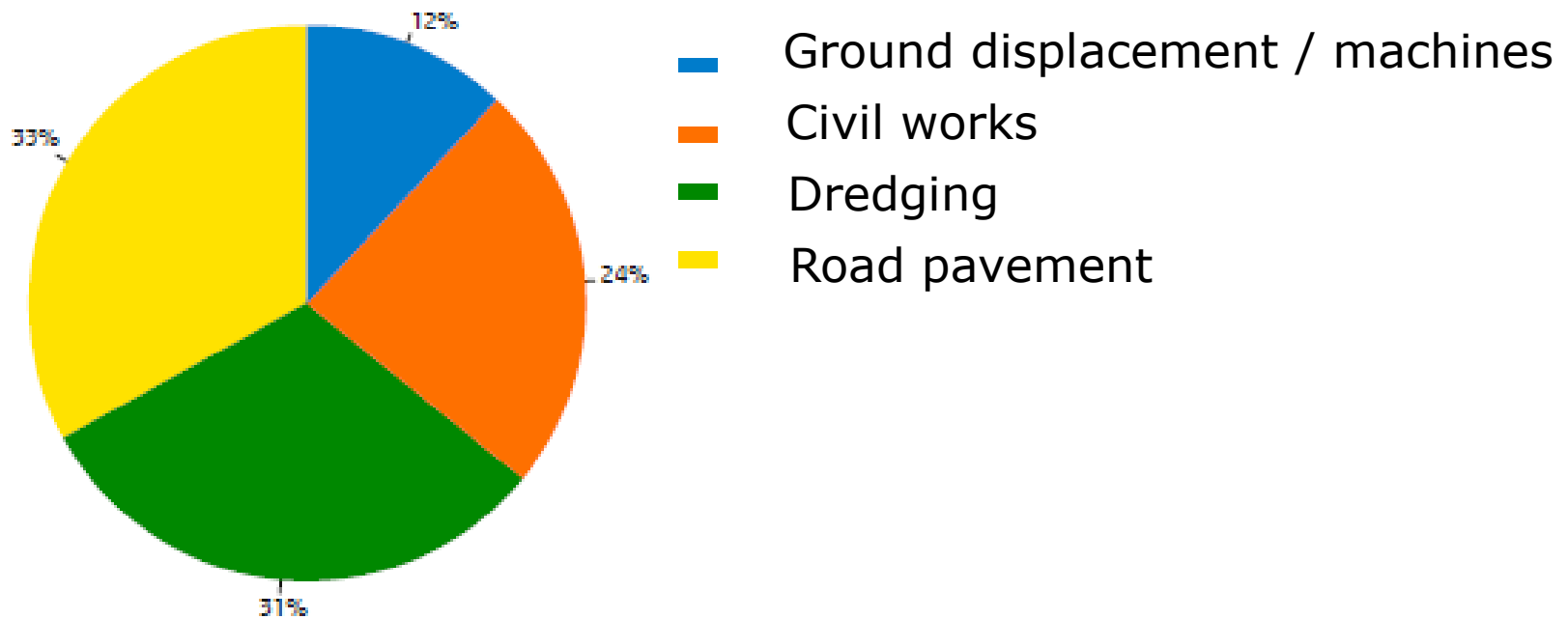


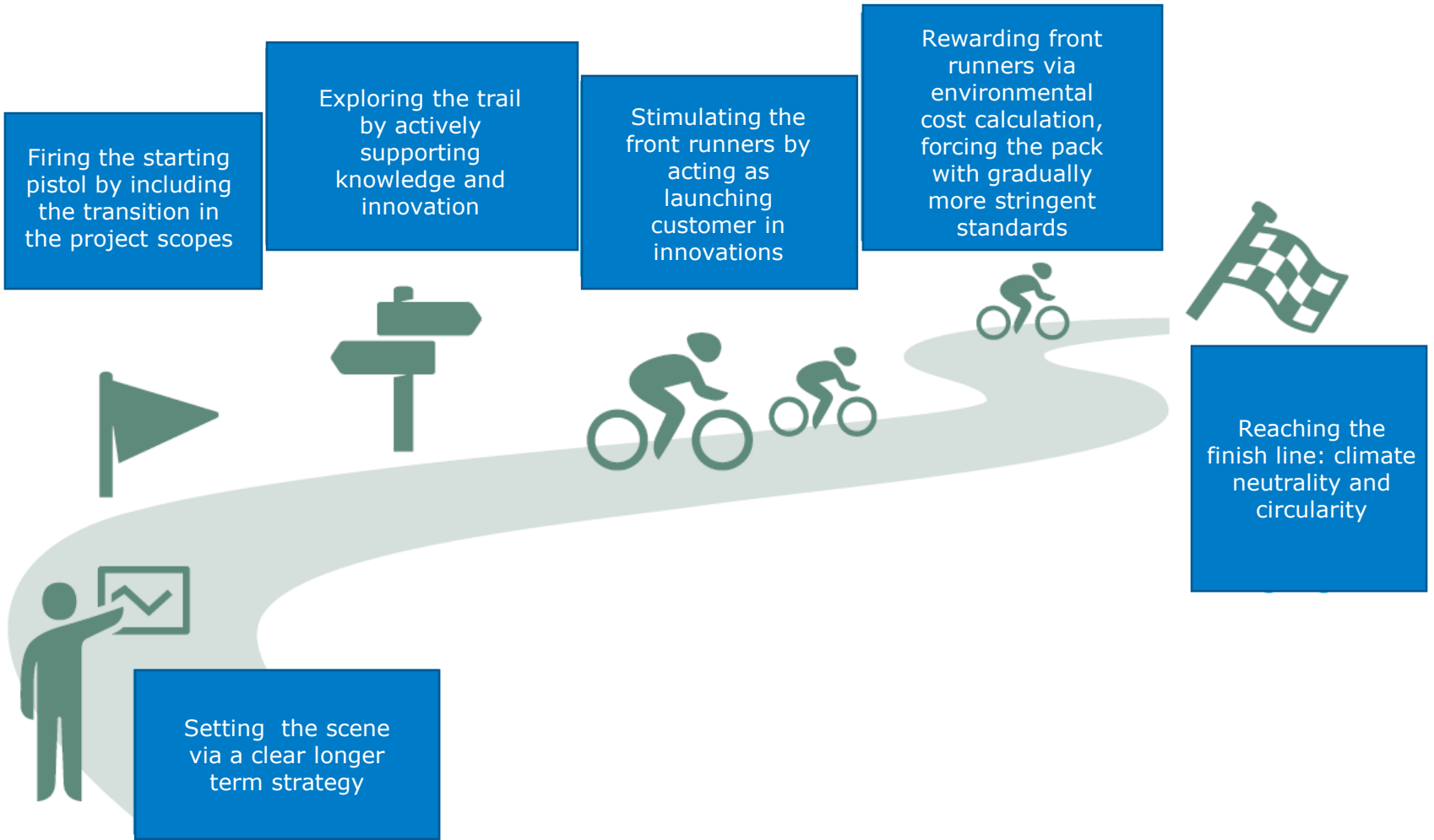
The climate transitions: goals and ambitions





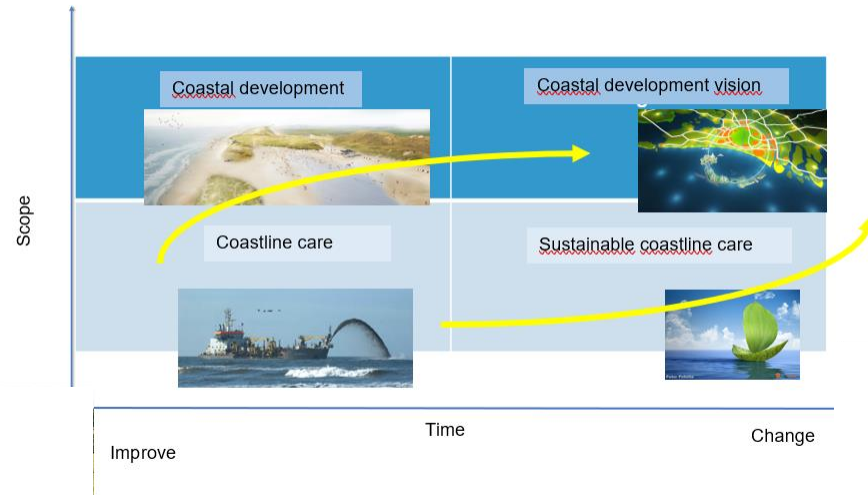
Coastal sand suppletion and maintenance dredging of waterways important share of total upstream footprint of Rijkswaterstaat (roughly 600 kt CO₂-eq./yr)

- Acting as launching customer: innovation partnerships related to coastline maintenance
